

# JULIANSTOWN TO BE BYPASSED

PLANS for the new Northern Motorway include a proposal to bypass the accident blackspot of Julianstown.

Local people were recently reported to be furious at missing out on this major bypass scheme for the Dublin-Belfast road. According to reports, the villagers were complaining that this planned thoroughfare would stop just short of Julianstown, extending from the Five Road junction on the south of Balbriggan, Co. Dublin, to Gormanston on the north.

However, a Meath Co. Council spokesman said yesterday (Tuesday) that the proposed motorway, which will take most of the through traffic off the existing Dublin-Belfast road, also will veer west of Julianstown. "The proposal is that Julianstown will be bypassed," he stressed.
